The Navy's elite flying squadron has released updates to their 2018 air show schedule, as well as a full 2019 tour calendar, the [Navy announced](#).

Modifications to the 2018 Blue Angels schedule include:

- Cancellation of March 17-18 shows in Tuscon, Arizona
- Addition of April 28-29 shows in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina
- Addition of October 13-14 shows in Minden-Tahoe, Nevada.
